



Community Impact Report - 2025

Between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025:

- ➔ The doors of PEER Wellness Center opened **20,572** times, (an average of **1,714** direct, free recovery support services delivered every month.)
- ➔ Acknowledging [“all pathways to recovery”](#), the recovery center hosted over **23** different types of peer-led support groups, resulting in a total of **4,196** recovery support groups that were attended **13,184** times.
- ➔ **229** volunteer/community service hours were provided by **84** individuals *(which not only assisted with center operations, but gave individuals the opportunity to develop purpose and connect in a meaningful way with others in recovery.)*
- ➔ The recovery community center provided **26** recovery-friendly social events, (such as Trunk-or-Treat, Game Nights, “Friendsgiving” potluck, a New Year/New Beginnings celebration, and JustUS BBQs), that were attended by **2,389** individuals.
- ➔ To reduce stigma and advocate for those of us who live with mental health and/or substance use disorder, PEER Wellness Center collaborated with **52** community stakeholders to organize **3** community wide events including a Mental Health Awareness Month Town-Hall Meeting, an International Overdose Awareness Day event and [*Boise’s 10th Annual Recovery Rally at Julia Davis Park](#) - which were attended by **3,054** community members.

- ➔ Our [“Day One” program](#) picked up **56** “Returning Citizens” upon their release after incarceration. We provided transportation and connected each individual with community resources then placed **564** [“Recovery Check-up”](#) calls/texts to provide ongoing support.
- ➔ To [prevent drug overdoses in our community](#), PEER Wellness Center distributed **1,114** naloxone and overdose prevention supplies and held **4** Overdose Reversal trainings.
