Code of Ethics Public Policy

Purpose:

This policy establishes the ethical framework governing all recovery support operations at PEER Wellness Center.

Scope:

Applies to all community center employees, board members, and active volunteers.

Policy:

PEER Wellness Center has adopted the National Association of Addiction Professionals' (NAADAC) Code of Ethics, *with strict adherence to Section X (Peer Support Ethics) and Section XI (Organizational Ethics)*, as its primary standard for conduct and ethical deliberations. It is the administrative policy of the center that all staff and representatives be held strictly accountable to the tenets described therein.

Compliance & Enforcement:

Violations of this code are subject to internal disciplinary action. Members of the public, participants, or families who observe a breach of this code are encouraged to file a formal report through the

- **Evidence-Based Screening & Self-Directed Planning:** Utilizing standard screening tools to offer brief interventions and referrals, while strictly supporting participants as they design their own self-directed Recovery Management or WRAP plans.
- **Confidentiality and Privacy:** Strictly safeguarding your personal information and recovery journey.
- **Professional Responsibility:** Maintaining clear boundaries, honesty, and high standards of personal conduct.
